












Festive cheer with gifts that spread joy while being kind to our planet







LONGEVITY OF TOYS

 Did you know, 90% of all kids' toys are made from plastic. Within 3 months of receiving these toys, as much as 40% are broken and ready for the landfill.




LESS IS MORE

- Kids are naturally good at playing.
- Research shows that kids own an average of 238 toys, but play with less than 5% of them!



CULTIVATE CREATIVITY

- Having fewer toys helps kids develop their creativity, imagination, and resourcefulness.
- Opt for a few open-ended multipurpose toys made of good quality or gift "experiences" rather than items.

Set yourself up for eco-gifting success!



- PLAN Make time to organise and think about what you want to buy. E.g. Make one bulk order from your favourite online store to save on delivery costs and emissions.
- **CONSIDER** Ask your friends and family what they need, this eliminates unwanted gifts. E.g. Check with your nephew's parents if he will enjoy a second-hand book before making an unnecessary purchase.
- PREPARE Panic buying leads to unwanted purchases, that end up in landfills. E.g. Set out an afternoon to make a list of all the people you want to gift, write down some gift ideas, and then go shopping.
- QUALITY Will this gift last and/or is there a more sustainable alternative? E.g. Open-ended gifts like building bricks or board games can be enjoyed many times over whilst an action figure might only be a short-term interest. Toys with flimsy edges or require batteries don't always have the longevity of more consciously produced gifts.
- LOOK FOR TRUSTED LABELS Seek out independent certifications of authenticity e.g. Organic (GOTS), Fairtrade, Forest Stewardship Council (FSC), Better Cotton Initiative (BCI), Non-GMO, Cruelty-Free, etc. E.g. Platforms like susGain feature their partner brands' verified sustainable best practices with badges.
- BUDGET Some ethical-, eco- and sustainable gifts may cost more than high street brands, consider if going smaller with a bigger impact feels good for you. On the flip side, the gift of time spent together or making something homemade doesn't have to cost you anything and may in many cases be the best gift to share.
- **PRESENTATION** Think about how you want to wrap, address, and present your gift. E.g. Use your children's old artwork as gift wrap or instead of shiny gift tags, label directly onto your gift wrap.
- IT'S NEW TO ME! Not all gifts have to be brand new.

 Books, toys, accessories, etc; hunting for the perfect pre-loved piece might be much more thoughtful than clicking the "buy now" button on the next e-commerce platform.



Gifts below \$20!

- Potted plants
- Framed photographs and artwork
- "Secret Santa". Opting to purchase one meaningful gift vs many smaller gifts is. A great way to eliminate any unwanted presents.
- **Vouchers.** Especially in situations where you are unsure about what the person you are giving to would appreciate (ie. "secret santa' at office), opt for a gift card, voucher or cash. It increases the chance of the recipient getting something useful to them.
- **Homemade treats** stored in a mason jar and wrapped in a tea towel.



Gifting Experiences

- Support causes: Find 11 local charities on susGain. Read up about their mission and programmes. Also explore giving.sg for many more local causes to support.
- **Gifting time together:** musical tickets, an afternoon in a waterpark, a pottery class, a romantic dinner etc..

More conscious gift wrapping ideas:

Use less of:

- Glitter and metallic Christmas wrapping – they shed microplastics
- Ribbon cannot be recycled
- Sticky tape cannot be recycled

Instead, opt for:

- Natural twine
- Tea towels
- Newspaper
- Brown virgin craft paper
- Children's artwork
- Painting or decorating the packaging box
- Plantables stationery that can be planted
- Reusable gift bags


